## 9. <u>NEW BUSINESS:</u>

**a. Preliminary Plat for Arcade Meadows Pod 3**; 173 lots on 63.45 acres; Fronting on the north side of Holiday Cemetery Road and the northeast side of B. Whitfield Road; Walton Global Holdings LLC by Stantec. Map/ Parcel 056 007 (part). Owner of Record RUC Holdings, ULC. Existing zoning: PCD Planned Community Development, Conditional (2nd Plan Submittal Date 12/07/23, received 12/08/23)

Motion made by Council member <u>Ron Smith</u> to approve the Preliminary Plat for Arcade Meadows Pod 3 with conditions #1-19 from the staff planner as stipulated to by the Applicant as noted in minutes from the *December 19, 2023 Planning Commission Meeting,* attached.

**b. RZ-2023-01 Annexation and Zoning:** Bull Investments, Inc. c/o David Altman, by David Elder, applicant, Joe A. Ginn, property owner, seeks annexation and C-2 (Highway Commercial) zoning of part of Parcel 070/ 012K totaling +/- 3.32 acres located south of Etheridge Road, north of Arcade Park Street, and east of U.S. Highway 129. Existing zoning is A-2 (Agricultural Rural Farm District) in unincorporated Jackson County. Proposed use: climate controlled mini-storage facility.

Motion made by Council member Cindy Bone to approve the Annexation and Rezoning application for RZ-2023-01 following the conditions recommended by the Planning Commission.

RZ-2023-01 Annexation and Rezoning to C-2 with the following 4 conditions:

- 1. Prohibited Uses: The following uses otherwise permitted in the C-2 zoning district shall be prohibited: convenience store with gasoline pumps; funeral home, mortuary or mausoleum; lodging service; open air business; tow service; and wrecked motor vehicle compound.
- 2. Buffer abutting unincorporated land: There shall be a 50-foot wide natural buffer along the north property line abutting unincorporated property.
- 3. **Building Height:** Building height shall have the appearance of a one-story building facing the east park property line.
- 4. **Owner**, at their sole cost and expense, shall design and construct a road 26-feet in width, paved with asphalt, on Parcel 070 012L directly adjacent to Parcel 070 012B3 connecting Arcade Park Street to the existing Arcade City Park property.

c. CU-2023-01 Conditional Use: Bull Investments, Inc. c/o David Altman, by David Elder, applicant, Joe A. Ginn, property owner, seeks a conditional use permit for a selfservice storage facility in a proposed C-2 (Highway Commercial) zoning district on property (part of Parcel 070/012K) totaling +/- 3.32 acres located south of Etheridge Road, north of Arcade Park Street, and east of U.S. Highway 129. Proposed use: climate controlled mini-storage facility.

Motion made by Council member Ron Smith to approve the Conditional Use application for CU-2023-01 following the conditions recommended by the Planning Commission.

CU-2023-01 Conditional Use with the following 5 conditions:

- 1. Buffer abutting unincorporated land: There shall be a 50-foot wide natural buffer along with north property line abutting unincorporated property.
- 2. Building Height: Building height shall have the appearance of a one story building facing the east park property line.
- 3. Building square footage maximum: The entire self-service storage facility shall be limited to 90,000 square feet including office space.
- 4. Outside storage: Any storage of RV's and Boats shall be under roof with 3-sides. This shall not exceed 10,000 square feet in area.
- 5. Conditional Use for the storage facility to only be located on the new proposed area in accordance with the new approved site plan.
