RECOMMENDED CONDITIONS OF ZONING:

If this request for annexation and C-2 zoning is approved, it should be approved C-2 Conditional, subject to the owner's agreement to abide by the following conditions of zoning:

- 1. **Use limitations.** The following uses otherwise permitted in the C-2 zoning district shall not be permitted on the subject property without review and approval by the Arcade City Council as a rezoning change:
 - a. Continuing care retirement community.
 - b. Crisis center.
 - c. Dormitory.
 - d. Group home.
 - e. Hospital.
 - f. Institutionalized residential living and care facility.
 - g. Funeral Home.
 - h. Mortuary or mausoleum.
 - i. Lodging Service.
 - j. Tow Service.
 - k. Wrecked motor vehicle compound.
 - l. Animal shelter or kennel.
 - m. Convenience Store with gas pumps.
- 2. **Dedication of right of way.** If required by the Jackson County Public Development Department, the owner shall dedicate to Jackson County at no cost to the City of Arcade or Jackson County additional right of way along the entire property frontage along Ethridge Road, prior to occupancy.
- 3. **Ethridge Road frontage landscaping and opaque fence.** Along the property's Ethridge Road frontage, a minimum 25-foot wide planted landscape strip with a minimum 8-foot high opaque fence shall be required interior to the required landscape strip.
- 4. **Storage setback.** A minimum 50-foot setback shall be required for all modular buildings stored on the site.
- 5. **Surfacing of lot.** The principal internal circulation driveway shall be paved. The remainder of the site should not require paving.
