Ordinance Amendment: 2025-01- An Ordinance Amending the Arcade Land Use Management Code, to amend Article 6, "Agricultural Zoning Districts," Table 6.1, "Permitted and Conditional Uses for Agricultural Zoning Districts" and Article 7, "Residential Zoning Districts," Table 7.1, "Permitted and Conditional Uses for Residential Zoning Districts," to Add Recreational Vehicle Occupancy for Residential Use as a Prohibited Use; to Amend Article 8, "Commercial and Industrial Zoning Districts," Table 8.1, "Permitted and Conditional Uses for Commercial and Industrial Zoning Districts," to Amend Use Permissions for Various Commercial and Industrial Zoning Districts and To Add Recreational Vehicle Occupancy for Residential Use as a Prohibited Use; to Amend Article 11, "Use Provisions," Chapter 11.2, "Principal Residential Uses," Section 11.2.3, "Dwellings, Single-Family and Two-Family, and Manufactured Homes," to Repeal Existing Provisions, Retitle said Section, and Revise and Adopt Standards for Manufactured Homes; and to Amend Article 2, "Definitions" as Appropriate to Define Additional Terms or Amend Existing Definitions. The city reserves the right to amend any other provision of the Land Use Management Code related to these topics, not specifically identified in this notice, to effectuate the desired changes.
